FREEDOM OF INFORMATION ACT 2000. MINISTRY OF DEFENCE POLICE: DYNAMIC RISK ASSESSMENT

I refer to your email of 1 August 2017, which was acknowledged on the 3 August 2017

We are treating your e-mail as a request for information in accordance with the Freedom of Information Act 2000 (FOIA 2000).

In your e-mail you requested the following information:

“Do all MoD Police Officers receive specific training in 'Dynamic Risk Assessment' in relation to day-to-day policing? If so may I have a copy of that training material”

A search for information has now been completed and I can confirm that some information in scope of your request is held by the Ministry of Defence Police. Please see below response:-

Do all MoD Police Officers receive specific training in 'Dynamic Risk Assessment' in relation to day-to-day policing? If so may I have a copy of that training material

All MDP Officers are mandated to complete training in Risk Assessment, which includes Dynamic Risk Assessment. This e-learning package is provided to police forces via the National Centre for Applied Learning Technologies (NCALT), so we do not own the training material.

Dynamic Risk Assessment is also used in such areas as Firearms and Dog Training, as part of their processes.

Specific roles within MDP are also required to complete a 4 day Institution of Occupational Safety and Health (IOSH), a nationally accredited course in Managing Risk Assessment,

which contains modules specific to Dynamic Risk Assessment. Again we do not own the training material for this course.
