FREEDOM OF INFORMATION ACT 2000 REQUEST REF: 0468-17

Thank you for your email of 12 May 2017 asking for information under the Freedom of Information Act (FOIA) 2000. You asked:

I am happy to reduce the scope of my request to the below. I am also happy to limit my request to the FCO offices based in the UK.

1) Please state the number of contracts in each of the following value bands that were due to expire in each financial year from 2012/13 to 2016/17, but were renewed without being put to competitive tender after expiring:

- a) £50m-£100m*
- b) £100m or more*

2) Please state the number of contracts in each of the following value bands that were due to expire in each financial year from 2012/13 to 2016/17 but were extended without being put to competitive tender after expiring:

- a) £50m-£100m*
- b) £100m or more*

3) For contracts with a value of more than £100m that were (a) renewed or (b) extended please provide the name of the private contractor, a description of the contract and the services to be provided, and the reason the contract was renewed without a competitive tender for each financial year from 2012/13 to 2016/17.

If providing information on contracts between £50m and £100m would breach the cost limit, please just provide information on contracts with a value of more than £100m.

I am writing to confirm that we have now completed the search for the information which you requested.

I can confirm that the Foreign and Commonwealth Office (FCO) does hold information relevant to your request.

All FCO commercial contracts of the value of £50m and above have been either tendered or extended before expiry in accordance with the terms of the contract.
