Thank you for your email of 16 May 2017 requesting the following information:

'I am writing to you in order to find out how much money (if any) is spent annually on the upkeep of the property on 65-69 Parkhurst Road, Islington.

Alternatively I would like to know how much money has been spent on the upkeep of the place since it was shut down or if the Ministry of Defence is not responsible for the upkeep of the property I would like to know who is.'

I am treating your correspondence as a request for information under the Freedom of Information Act 2000 (FOIA).

A search for the information has now been completed within the Ministry of Defence (MOD) and I can confirm that no information in scope of your request is held.

Under Section 16 of the Act (Advice and Assistance) you may find it helpful to note that 65-69 Parkhurst Road was sold in 2013 to Finsbury Dials.

If you are not satisfied with this response or you wish to complain about any aspect of the handling of your request, then you should contact me in the first instance. If informal resolution is not possible and you are still dissatisfied then you may apply for an independent internal review by contacting the Information Rights Compliance team, Ground Floor, MOD Main Building, Whitehall, SW1A 2HB (e-mail CIO-FOI-IR@mod.uk). Please note that any request for an internal review must be made within 40 working days of the date on which the attempt to reach informal resolution has come to an end.

If you remain dissatisfied following an internal review, you may take your complaint to the Information Commissioner under the provisions of Section 50 of the Freedom of Information Act. Please note that the Information Commissioner will not investigate your case until the MOD internal review process has been completed.
