DESCRIPTION OF SITE: An area of open moorland containing a small arms range and resulting Danger Area on Cardinham Moor, Bodmin Moor. HECTARAGE OF DIRECTION: 201.27					
DESCRIPTION OF MILITARY USE: Millpool Range is used for live small arms firing. It has an associated Danger Area. The range itself is fenced and signed with warning notices. The Danger Area is unfenced but marked with warning signs and MOD standard red/white Danger Poles.					
CURRENT PUBLIC ACCESS: There are numerous footpaths that traverse the Danger Area. Public access is controlled during live firing by red flags. Open access is permitted when the red flags are not displayed. There is no public access to the fenced area that contains the range infrastructure.					
ORIGINAL S28 JUSTIFICATION: 1. The habitat criteria for CROW mapping has created the situation where a live firing danger area has been mapped as access land. It is MOD policy that all land within any Danger Area must be subject to restriction in the interest of clarity and public safety. 2. MOD intends to create byelaws for this area under the current byelaw review programme resulting in this land being excepted from CROW access legislation. Any byelaw proposals will be subject to public consultation.					
REVIEW COMMENTS: The Military Use section is still relevant. The original s28 justification remains valid and there is a continued need for a s28 CROW direction.
