UNDEB CENEDLAETHOL ATHRAWON CYMRU

We have audited the financial statements of UCAC for the year ended 31st December 2016 which comprises the Income and Expenditure Account, the Balance Sheet and the related notes. Those standards require us to comply with the Auditing Practices Board's (APB's Ethical Standards for Auditors).
