DWP response

In response to your question please see the attached document (FOI 2012-4510 Response.xls) which gives the number of **Housing Benefit (HB)** recipients in Barking and Dagenham by Ethnicity and Caseload Month: April 2011 – March 2012.

Please note that the information given relates to HB recipients only, which may be a single person or a couple.

Please also note that the figures have been derived from datasets used to produce National Statistics on HB and the ethnicity of benefit claimants but they have not been quality assured to National Statistics or Official Statistics publication standard.

Information on the ethnicity of HB recipients is only available for recipients who have also been in receipt of, or are receiving, another DWP administered benefit where ethnicity is recorded as part of the claim process, for example Jobseeker's Allowance (JSA). Therefore a significant number of recipients will have an unknown ethnicity. This information should therefore be treated with caution.
