As a local person, I thought "localism" had finally been recognised. But here we go again.

The previous years of uncertainty are back as big developers try to over-run the residents of Mid Wales. The voice of the local people has been loud and very clear from the start – I have never seen such passion in opposing something!

This industrialisation of wind farms and associated lines will further blight the Welsh landscape. I note the removal of 5 turbines at Carnedd Wen as a token gesture – but obviously this will not make a difference as 5 out of the proposed 80 turbines (from both sites) will not make any difference.
