## **FREEDOM OF INFORMATION ACT 2000: MINISTRY OF DEFENCE POLICE: ASSAULTS ON MDP OFFICERS**

We refer to your email dated 16 August 2017 which was acknowledged on the 17 August 2017.

We are treating your email as a request for information in accordance with the Freedom of Information Act 2000 (FOIA 2000).

In your email you requested the following information:

**“Please can you tell me the number of police staff (broken down by job title and gender), who have been assaulted in the last 12-months (July 2016-2017), please?**

**I would also like to know the nature of these injuries and what compensation was given to those assaulted.”**

A search for information has now been completed and I can confirm that some information in scope of your request is held by the Ministry of Defence Police (MDP).

Within the last 12 months the following assaults were recorded by MDP:-

Male Officer	Scratches to arms whilst detaining an individual
Male Officer	Bitten by individual during arrest. Bite punctured skin, drawing blood
Male Officer	Laser pen shone in eye whilst restraining an individual causing disturbance

No compensation has been paid to any of these officers to date.
