DECLARATION OF NATIONAL NATURE RESERVE

**PARISH OF PAINSWICK
COUNTY OF GLOUCESTERSHIRE**

NOTICE is hereby given that:

in pursuance of section 19(1) of the National Parks and Access to the Countryside Act 1949 and section 35(1) of the Wildlife and Countryside Act 1981 and all other powers enabling them in that behalf, Natural England has, by the Cotswold Commons and Beechwoods National Nature Reserve Declaration No. 6 made on the 23rd day of February 2017, declared that the National Nature Reserve is extended to include the land referred to therein.

The land having a total area of 3.68 hectares or thereabouts, situated in the Parish of Painswick in the County of Gloucestershire and shown single hatched and shaded yellow on the maps attached to the said Declaration has been acquired and is held by Natural England. The said land is being managed as a nature reserve, and Natural England is satisfied that the land is of national importance.

Certified copies of the Cotswold Commons and Beechwoods National Nature Reserve No. 6 Declaration 2017 have been deposited for public inspection free of charge for one month during normal office hours at the offices of Gloucestershire County Council, Stroud District Council and at the offices of Natural England at County Hall, Spetchley Road, Worcester WR5 2NP.
