Summer Reading Challenge 2017 - the results are out

- 761,758 children took part in Animal Agents across the UK, an increase of 6,550 on 2016's total.
- 44% of them were boys.
- 7,763 Reading Hack volunteers aged 12 to 24 took part



And next year's theme is Mischief Makers - inspired by the iconic children's title **Beano**, which celebrates its 80th anniversary next year.
