# FREEDOM OF INFORMATION ACT 2000: MINISTRY OF DEFENCE POLICE: POLICE RESIGNATIONS

We refer to your email dated 8 March 2017 which was acknowledged on the 9 March 2017.

We are treating your email as a request for information in accordance with the Freedom of Information Act 2000 (FOIA 2000).

In your email of the 8 March 2017 you requested the following information:

"I would like to receive information regarding police resignations.

#### Specifically, I would like to know:

- A year by year breakdown of the number of Police Officer resignations in each financial year from 2011/2012 to the most recently recorded date, along with a breakdown of the reasons for resigning.
- A year by year breakdown of the number of Police Officer retirements in each financial year from 2011/2012 to the most recently recorded date."

A search for information has now been completed and I can confirm that information in scope of your request is held by the Ministry of Defence Police (MDP).

Please see Annex A attached for the information you have requested.

If you are not satisfied with this response or wish to complain about any aspect of the handling of your request, then you should contact me in the first instance. If informal resolution is not possible and you are still dissatisfied then you may apply for an independent internal review by contacting the Information Rights Compliance team, Ground Floor, MOD Main Building, Whitehall, London SW1A 2HB (email CIO-FOI-IR@mod.uk).

Please note that any request for an internal review must be made within 40 working days of the date on which the attempt to reach informal resolution has come to an end. If you remain dissatisfied following an internal review, you may take your complaint to the Information Commissioner under the provisions of Section 50 of the Freedom of Information Act. Please note that the Information Commissioner will not investigate the case until the MOD internal review process has been completed.
