- “• **How many hate crimes have been reported in the last five financial years (2012-13, 2013-14, 2014-15, 2015-16, 2016-17)? Please can you break this down more specifically by type of hate crime if possible.**
- **Please can you provide detail what action was taken with these reported hate crimes. How many of the cases s reported in the last five years resulted in a) a charge, b) a summons, c) caution, d) restorative justice or e) no action taken?.”**

A search for information has now been completed and I can confirm that information within the scope of your request is held.

attempt to reach informal resolution has come to an end.

If you remain dissatisfied following an internal review, you may take your complaint to the Information Commissioner under the provisions of Section 50 of the Freedom of Information Act. Please note that the Information Commissioner will not investigate the case until the MOD internal review process has been completed.
