DESCRIPTION OF SITE: Small area of rough grassland adjoining the road around the access points to the 'Northern Extension' to STANTA. The grassland area is interspersed with gorse and scrub. The site lies directly opposite and overlooks Bodney Camp.					
HECTARAGE OF DIRECTION: 24.61					
DESCRIPTION OF MILITARY USE: The mapped area is the main entrance area to the Northern Extension of STANTA. The area is a troop gathering point where only authorised personnel may be present. Troop gathering includes not only movement on foot but heavy vehicle use as well. The area is also utilised for dry training including intensive use of pyrotechnics.					
CURRENT PUBLIC ACCESS: There is currently no public access to the mapped area.					
ORIGINAL S28 JUSTIFICATION: 1. The mapped area forms part of the Northern Extension to STANTA which is used for infantry training and vehicle massing. There should be no public access because this is incompatible with the defence related activity. 2. MOD intends to review byelaws for STANTA under the current byelaw review programme to include this area resulting in this land being permanently excepted from CROW access legislation. Any proposals for byelaws will be subject to public consultation.					
REVIEW COMMENTS: The Military Use section is still relevant. The original s28 justification remains valid and there is a continued need for a s28 CROW direction.
