Thank you for your Freedom of Information enquiry of 11 September 2017.

You asked for the following information:

"The Governments net income for the financial year 2015/2016 from the sale of both petroleum and diesel fuels in the United Kingdom.

Should these figures be specifically available for England, Ireland, Scotland and Wales I would appreciate the breakdown."
