QUESTION TOPICS

The Department for Culture, Media and Sport and its partner organisations are also interested in the experiences and views of children aged 11-15. The Department needs to understand how much time children spend doing sports and cultural activities – both in and out of school – so that they can improve the opportunities available to them.

If your child agrees, the interviewer will ask them questions about the following:

- Taking part in arts activities and going to arts events.
- Visiting the library and archives.
- Visiting historical places.
- Visiting museums.
- Taking part in sports and recreational activities.

The interviewer will ask about doing these activities in the last 12 months (4 weeks for sport) and in the last 7 days. In addition we will also ask how happy they are.

The interview will take around 20 minutes.

At your child's request the interviewer will stop the interview at any time or skip any question they do not want to answer.

Everything your child says will be treated as strictly confidential.
