

Erratum to the 2016 summer exam series report



Reason for changes

Some data were interpreted incorrectly leading to incorrect figures being published. Other forms of modified papers and support materials were included in the calculation in error. The corrected figures now represent the total number of standard question papers and support materials produced for GCSE, AS and A levels in England for 2016.

Corrections

Infographic, under 'Phase 1'

The figure '18.2k' should be 2,888 and should reference 'GCSE, AS and A level standard question papers and support materials in England'.

On the pie chart, the percentage '0.16%' should be '1.0%'.

Page 8, paragraph 2, sentence 2

'For summer 2016, the exam boards developed nearly 18,200 question papers and supporting stimulus materials. '

should read:
