**FREEDOM OF INFORMATION ACT 2000: MINISTRY OF DEFENCE POLICE: DOG EQUIPMENT**

We refer to your email dated 4 February 2017 which was acknowledged on the 6 February 2017.

We are treating your email as a request for information in accordance with the Freedom of Information Act 2000 (FOIA 2000).

In your email of the 4 February 2017 you requested the following information:

**“Can you please tell me where you get you dog equipment from and what would be issued to a general purpose dog handler type of leads collar brush ect”**

A search for information has now been completed and I can confirm that information in scope of your request is held.

Currently all Ministry of Defence Police (MDP) general purpose dog handlers are issued with –

Leash  
Collar  
Muzzle  
Grooming Comb / brush  
Harness  
Control line  
Dog Toy  
Dog Bedding  
Feed bowl  
Water bowl

All dog equipment for the MDP is obtained through a wider Defence procurement contract.

If you are not satisfied with this response or wish to complain about any aspect of the handling of your request, then you should contact me in the first instance. If informal resolution is not possible and you are still dissatisfied then you may apply for an independent internal review by contacting the Information Rights Compliance team, Ground Floor, MOD Main Building, Whitehall, London SW1A 2HB (email [CIO-FOI-IR@mod.uk](mailto:CIO-FOI-IR@mod.uk)).

Please note that any request for an internal review must be made within 40 working days of the date on which the attempt to reach informal resolution has come to an end. If you remain dissatisfied following an internal review, you may take your complaint to the Information Commissioner under the provisions of Section 50 of the Freedom of Information Act. Please note that the Information Commissioner will not investigate the case until the MOD internal review process has been completed.
