Annexation

- 1. Annexation is the formal incorporation of territory into the Crown's dominions, whether it was acquired by conquest or was ceded to the Crown by another power.
- 2. Under **s.12(1)(a)** of the **British Nationality Act 1948**, a person who became a BS by reason of the annexation of any territory included on 1 January 1949 in the UK and Colonies became a CUKC on that date. This applied mainly to the people of:
 - Cyprus, which was annexed in 1914
 - North Borneo and Sarawak, which were annexed in 1946
- 2. The most recent acquisition by this means is the uninhabited island of Rockall, which lies to the west of the Hebrides and was annexed in 1955.
