Definitive Map Modification Order (No 22) 2016 Byways Open to All Traffic Nos 9 & 56 (Parishes of Ewart & Kirknewton)

Notice is hereby given that the above referenced Order has been submitted to the Secretary of State for Environment, Food and Rural Affairs for determination. An Inspector will be appointed by the Secretary of State to determine the Order.

The start date for the above Order is 14 November 2017.

Consideration of the Order will take the form of exchanges of statements of case and comments on statements of case.

The effect of the Order, if confirmed without modifications, will be to modify the definitive map and statement for the area by:-

Former Berwick-upon-Tweed Borough

Byway Open to All Traffic No 9 (Parish of Ewart)

Adding thereto a byway open to all traffic, from a point marked H on the Order plan, at the junction of the U1019 and U1021 roads, 240 metres north-east of Coupland Castle, in a general southerly direction along part of the U1019 road, for a distance of 465 metres, to a point marked J, on alleged Byway Open to All Traffic No 56 in the Parish of Kirknewton, at a ford through the River Glen.

Byway Open to All Traffic No 56 (Parish of Kirknewton)

Adding thereto a byway open to all traffic, from a point marked J at a ford through the River Glen, in a general south-easterly then south-westerly direction along part of the U1019 road for a distance of 785 metres, to a point marked K, on the B6351 road at Yeavering.

Timetable for sending in statements of case and comments

Within 2 weeks of the start date [by 28 November 2017]

The Order Making Authority must ensure their statement of case is received by the Secretary of State. As soon as possible after the deadline, the Secretary of State will send a copy (excluding copies of any supporting documents - these will be available to view at the Authority's offices) to everyone who has made an objection or representation, the applicant and any other person who has written to us in respect of the Order.

Within 8 weeks of the start date [by 9 January 2018]

Everyone who has made an objection or representation or any other written representation must ensure their statement of case is received by the Secretary of State. As soon as possible after the deadline, the Secretary of State will send full copies to the Authority. Copies (excluding copies of any supporting documents - these will be available to view at the Authority's offices) will also be sent to the applicant, every person who has made an objection or representation and any other person who has written to us in respect of the Order.

Within the same period the applicant (if applicable) must ensure their statement of case is received by the Secretary of State. As soon as possible after the deadline, Secretary of State will send a full copy to the Authority. Copies will also be sent to everyone who has made an objection or representation and any other person who has written to us in respect of the Order (excluding copies of any supporting documents - these will be available to view at the Authority's offices).

Within 14 weeks of the start date [by 20 February 2018]

Everyone who has made an objection or representation, the Authority, the applicant (if applicable) and anyone who has written to us in respect of the Order must ensure that their comments on any or every other statement of case is received by the Secretary of State. As soon as possible after the deadline, the Secretary of State will send copies of these comments to everyone else.

Any other person wishing to make representations in writing to the Secretary of State in respect of the above Order must do so in line with the timetable set out above.

In fairness to the other parties <u>everyone should keep to the timetable</u> to ensure that statements of case and comments are received on time. Late documents will be returned.

This Order is made by Northumberland County Council under Section 53(2)(b) of the Wildlife and Countryside Act 1981 ("the Act") because it appears to that authority that the Definitive Map and Statement of Public Rights of Way for the County of Northumberland require modification in consequence of the occurrence of events specified in Section 53(3)(c)(i), namely, the discovery by the authority of evidence which (when considered with all other relevant evidence available to them) shows that a right of way which is not shown in the map and statement subsists or is reasonably alleged to subsist over land in the area to which the map relates, being a right of way such that the land over which the right subsists is a public path, a restricted byway or, subject to section 54A, a byway open to all traffic.

The authority has consulted every local authority whose area includes the land to which the order relates. The Northumberland County Council hereby order that:

- 1. For the purposes of this Order the relevant date is 1 July 2016.
- 2. The Definitive Map and Statement of Public Rights of Way for the County of Northumberland shall be modified as described in the Schedule and shown on the map attached to the Order.
- 3. This Order shall take effect on the date it is confirmed and may be cited as The Northumberland County Council Definitive Map Modification Order (No 22) 2016.


