Further to the notice issued on 14 July 2017, the Secretary of State for Transport confirms that the exemption granted by article 3 of the Railways (Provision etc. of Railway Facilities) (Exemptions) Order 2005 from section 16A(2) (Provision, improvement and development of railway facilities) of the Railways Act 1993 is revoked from the date set out in the attached notice (the "Notice") in relation to that part of the light maintenance depot currently known as North Pole International identified in the plan attached to the Notice.

The Secretary of State for Transport gives notice pursuant to article 4(1) of the Railways (Provision etc. of Railway Facilities) (Exemptions) Order 2005 ("the Order") that the exemption granted by article 3 of that Order from section 16A(2) (Provision, improvement and development of railway facilities) of the Railways Act 1993 is revoked from 6 September 2017 in relation to that part of the light maintenance depot currently known as North Pole International, at Mitre Way, London W10 6AT which is used primarily for the maintenance of rolling stock for domestic passenger services (identified in the plan attached to this notice).

North Pole International was originally built for the Eurostar fleet and was de-regulated from section 16A(2) of the Railways Act 1993 accordingly. Part of that light maintenance depot is now to be used for the Intercity Express Programme and will be used primarily to maintain rolling stock for domestic use and therefore it is appropriate to re-designate that part.
