

# **NOTICE OF ORDER**

## **WILDLIFE AND COUNTRYSIDE ACT 1981**

### **SECTION 53**

Slough Borough Council  
Bridleway 93 Modification Order 2015

Notice is hereby given that the above referenced Order has been submitted to the Secretary of State for Environment, Food and Rural Affairs for determination. Following an earlier inquiry, the Inspector appointed to determine the Order issued a letter in which he proposed to make modifications to the Order as drafted. Following advertisement of those proposals objections/representations have been received.

The **start date** for the above Order(s) is **02 June 2017**

Consideration of the Order will take the form of exchanges of statements of case and comments on statements of case which contain evidence in respect of the modified part of the Order **and** new evidence in respect of the unmodified part of the Order – specifically confined to the status and width of the route.

The effect of the Order, if confirmed without modifications will be to modify the definitive map and statement for the area by adding to them the bridleway which commences at point A (grid reference SU499717, 179525) on the south side of the adopted highway known as Langley Road running south as Blandford Road North for a distance of 119 metres to point B (grid reference SU499715, 179407) at the northern boundary of the adopted highway verge and footway known as Blandford Road South.

- The effect of the proposed modifications(s) would be to Delete all of the references in the Order to “*bridleway*” and insert “*byway open to all traffic*”.
- Replace the notation on the Order Map for a bridleway with the notation for a byway open to all traffic and amend the map key accordingly.
- Replace the existing widths of the relevant sections of the route shown on the Order Map with a width of 9 metres.

### **Timetable for sending in statements of case and comments**

#### **Within 8 weeks of the start date by 28 July 2017**

The Order Making Authority, the applicant and everyone who has made an objection or representation following the proposed modification(s) or any other written representation must ensure their statement of case is received by the Secretary of State. As soon as possible after receiving it the Secretary of State will send a full copy to the Authority. Copies (excluding copies of any supporting documents - these will be available to view at the Authority's offices) will also be sent to everyone who has made an objection or representation following the proposed modification, the applicant and any other person who has previously written to us in respect of the Order.

#### **Within 14 weeks of the start date by 08 September 2017**

Everyone who has made an objection or representation following the proposed modification(s), the Authority, the applicant (if applicable) and anyone who has written to us in respect of the Order must ensure their comments on any or every other statement of case is received by the Secretary of State. As soon as possible after the above date, the Secretary of State will send copies of the comments received to everyone else.

Any other person wishing to make representations in writing to the Secretary of State in respect of the above Order(s) must do so in line with the timetable set out above.

In fairness to the other parties everyone should keep to the timetable to ensure that statements of case and comments are received on time.

All parties must keep to the timetable set out above and ensure that statements of case are received by the Secretary of State on time. Late documents will be returned.
