

NOTICE OF ORDER

WILDLIFE AND COUNTRYSIDE ACT 1981 SECTION 53

Cornwall Council
(Addition of Restricted Byway from road U6036 to Bridleway 62
Camborne) (Penponds) Modification Order 2016

Notice is hereby given that the above referenced Order has been submitted to the Secretary of State for Environment, Food and Rural Affairs for determination. Following an earlier inquiry, the Inspector appointed to determine the Order issued a letter in which she proposed to make modifications to the Order as drafted. Following advertisement of those proposals objections/representations have been received.

The **start date** for the above Order is **27 February 2018**.

Consideration of the Order will take the form of exchanges of statements of case and comments on statements of case which contain evidence in respect of the Inspector's proposed modifications only.

The effect of the Order, if confirmed without modifications will be to modify the definitive map and statement for the area by adding to them a length of Restricted Byway in the Parish of Camborne commencing at Unclassified Road U6036 ("Mill Road") in Penponds approximately 15 metres west-north-west of "Mill Cottage" at Ordnance Survey Grid Reference (OSGR) SW 6321/3869 shown as point "A" on the Order Map thence running in a generally south-south-easterly direction for 190 metres and terminating at Bridleway Number 62 Camborne approximately 90 metres north of "40 New Road" at OSGR SW 6328/3852 shown as point "B" on the Order Map.

The effect of the proposed modifications would be to provide for the following:

- Throughout the Order:
- replace text "...*restricted byway*..." with text "...*footpath*...";
- Within Part II of the Schedule:
 - add box for '*Maximum width*' at "5 metres" adding a note that this is "*In accordance with the depiction of the way on map sheet Cornwall LXII.16 from the Ordnance Survey County Series Second Edition published at 1:2500 scale.*"
- On Order map:
 - alter the line to show the route as a footpath between points A and B, by a continuous line with short bars at intervals;
 - alter the key to show footpath.

Timetable for sending in statements of case and comments

Within 8 weeks of the start date [by 24 April 2018]

The Order Making Authority, the applicant and everyone who has made an objection or representation following the proposed modifications or any other written representation must ensure their statement of case is received by the Secretary of State. As soon as possible after receiving it the Secretary of State will send a full copy to the Authority. Copies (excluding copies of any supporting documents - these will be available to view at the Authority's offices) will also be sent to everyone who has made an objection or representation following the proposed modifications, the applicant and any other person who has previously written to us in respect of the Order.

Within 14 weeks of the start date [by 5 June 2018]

Everyone who has made an objection or representation following the proposed modifications, the Authority, the applicant (if applicable) and anyone who has written to us in respect of the Order must ensure their comments on any or every other statement of case is received by the Secretary of State. As soon as possible after the above date, the Secretary of State will send copies of the comments received to everyone else.

Any other person wishing to make representations in writing to the Secretary of State in respect of the above Order must do so in line with the timetable set out above.

In fairness to the other parties everyone should keep to the timetable to ensure that statements of case and comments are received on time.

All parties must keep to the timetable set out above and ensure that statements of case are received by the Secretary of State on time. Late documents will be returned.
