## Additional administration subsidy for 2012/13

- In circular HB/CTB S3/2011 the Department announced that £464.7m core funding would be made available to local authorities for 2012/13. We also advised that if any additional recession funding became available we would announce this at the earliest opportunity.
- We can now advise authorities that we have secured additional recession funding of £46m and the distribution of this amount, together with the core funding is currently under discussion with Local Authority Association representatives.
- It is expected that individual local authority amounts will be announced by circular once the distribution has been agreed later in the year.
