Information about our Moorings

We have annual and short stay moorings available at several locations across the Anglian Waterways; the River Nene at Northampton Marina, the River Great Ouse system at Denver and Upware and on the Ancholme at South Ferriby and Brigg.

Denver - Ely Ouse

On the banks of the River Great Ouse we have 57 leisure moorings, overlooking the historic flood defence structures at Denver Complex near to Downham Market.

Upware - Reach Lode

In the village of Upware close to Cambridge and Ely, we have 48 leisure moorings. At this location the surrounding land is lower than the river, providing excellent views across the fens.

South Ferriby - Ancholme/Humber

Located at the mouth of the River Ancholme we have leisure moorings overlooking the lock entrance with direct access to the Humber.

Brigg - Ancholme

Situated close to the town of Brigg we have 11 leisure moorings opposite the town leisure centre. These moorings are ideally situated for exploring the Ancholme navigation.

Boating Information Vessel Registration Requirements

All vessels kept, used or let for hire on Anglian Waterways must be registered with the Environment Agency (EA) or with the Canal & River Trust (CRT) on a Gold Licence. Please note a CRT standard river and canal licence does not cover you on Anglian Waterways. Annual or short term (1, 7 or 31 days) EA registrations can be obtained by contacting our boat registration team on 03708 506 506.





Northampton Marina

Northampton Marina offers high quality residential, permanent, visitor and winter moorings, nestled alongside Becket's Park on the River Nene in Northampton. It has a secluded, countryside feel whilst being within easy walking distance of the town centre. Located at the junction of the River Nene and the Northampton Arm of the Grand Union Canal, Northampton Marina is the ideal base for exploring both the Anglian Waterways and the wider canal network. The marina offers boaters a friendly and welcome place to stay with access to a choice of cruising routes. Within the secure site, accessed by key fob only, each of our rise and fall pontoons are constructed using non-slip surfaces and are designed with disabled access in mind. Our award winning facilities building is open to all visiting customers where you will find modern shower rooms, which include disabled facilities and a laundry room with washing and drying machines. Our landscaped grounds and wildflower meadow provide a recreation area with BBQs, picnic tables and cycle storage.

Central Location

Tha Marina has the feel of a quiet, coutryside location yet has easy access to the town centre's facilities including a wide range of shops, markets, pubs, restaurants, theatres, cinemas, the main hospital and national rail and bus networks.

Secure site

Each berth has rise and fall pontoons with non-slip decking and individual electricity and water supply. Inside the facilities building are quality washrooms and a laundry room. Outside there is a pump-out unit, chemical toilet disposal point, rubbish collection and recycling area and cycle storage. We also provide PO boxes for full residents.
