FREEDOM OF INFORMATION ACT 2000. MINISTRY OF DEFENCE POLICE: MDP OFFICER DEATHS

I refer to your e-mail of 27 December 2017, which was acknowledged on the 28 December 2017.

We are treating your e-mail as a request for information in accordance with the Freedom of Information Act 2000 (FOIA 2000).

In your e-mail you requested the following information:

“Please could you provide a list of all officers who have died between January 1 2002 and 1 December 2017, both on and off duty, while working for your force alongside the cause of death.

Could it be made clear where an officer has died on or off duty as well and the year in which they died?

Could this information be provided in spreadsheet format please?

Eg - Officer - killed in RTA - on duty - 2005 Officer - suicide - off duty – 2010”

A search for information has now been completed by the Ministry of Defence Police and I can confirm that we do hold some information in scope of your request.

Please note we do not hold details on whether the officer was on duty or off duty at the time of death. Under section 40(2) of the data protection act (personal information) we are unable to give details of the cause of death.

See the details below which is from October 2003, as no records are held before this time.
