Thank you for your request for information about a live animal export which we received on 20 February 2018. Your request has been handled under the Freedom of Information Act 2000.

The information you requested and our response is detailed below:

"Sir I am requesting under an FOI Request the following Information on Live animal shipments from the UK on Friday 9 November 2017. via Ramsgate Port

The loading and inspection reports together with the Ramsgate Portal APHA inspection reports including time of first sheep loading.

Also the completed and returned Journey Logs for the following Livestock Transporters for Friday 9 November 2017

A Tractor BT-JD-75 Trailer OD-39-DD

B Tractor /trailer R730 EUB"

Please see Appendices 1 to 5 for all loading and inspection reports, mid-journey compliance check and completed journey logs. The time of first loading is within these documents.

Following a search of our paper and electronic records, we can confirm the mid-journey compliance report for vehicle BTJD75/OD39DD is not held by APHA. This is because APHA did not undertake this at the Ramsgate Port.
