The Trade Marks (Amendment) Rules 1980

Made	19th February 1980

Whereas, in pursuance of the requirements of section 40(3) of the Trade Marks Act 1938(a), the Secretary of State has, before making the following Rules under that Act, published notice of his intention to make such Rules and of the place where copies of the draft Rules might be obtained by advertising such notice in the Trade Marks Journal and the Official Journal (Patents) on 23rd January 1980 and 30th January 1980, being the manner which he considered most expedient so as to enable persons affected to make representations to him before the Rules were finally settled:

Now, therefore, the Secretary of State, in exercise of powers conferred by sections 40 and 41 of the Trade Marks Act 1938 and now vested in him(b) and with the sanction of the Treasury, hereby makes the following Rules:-

- 1. These Rules may be cited as the Trade Marks (Amendment) Rules 1980 and shall come into operation as respects rules 1 and 3 on 14th March 1980 and as respects rule 2 on 6th May 1980.
- 2. For Schedule 1 to the Trade Marks Rules 1938(c) there shall be substituted the Schedule hereto and the Trade Marks (Amendment) Rules 1978(d) shall thereupon be revoked.
- 3. Where on or after 14th March 1980 but before 6th May 1980 Form T.M. No. 11 is filed in respect of the renewal of registration of a trade mark or a series of trade marks the last registration of which mark or series of marks is due to expire on or after 6th May 1980, the fee payable in respect of such renewal shall be that which would be payable if the said form were filed on or after 6th May 1980 and rule 2 of these Rules had come into operation.
