Application for Anonymity

Guidance Notes

The Application for Anonymity form should be used when applying to the tribunal to remove references to your name from all published documents.

You should complete each section fully including your full name, date of birth and address. Where you are applying for anonymity at the same time as submitting your appeal you should include your Home Office reference number or if you have already appealed, and you have been notified of it, your appeal number. Both will help the tribunal correctly identify your appeal. Please also include details of your legal representative, should you have one.

You need to provide the tribunal with reasons why you consider your appeal should be granted anonymity. Please use the box provided for this purpose and attach additional sheets should you need to. It is important that you provide full reasons why you are applying for anonymity on the form.

Please ensure that you read and understand the notes on the form, particularly regarding your own responsibility to maintain anonymity, before signing and dating the declaration.

Once completed, enclose the form with your completed appeal form or, if you have already lodged your appeal with the tribunal, send it to
