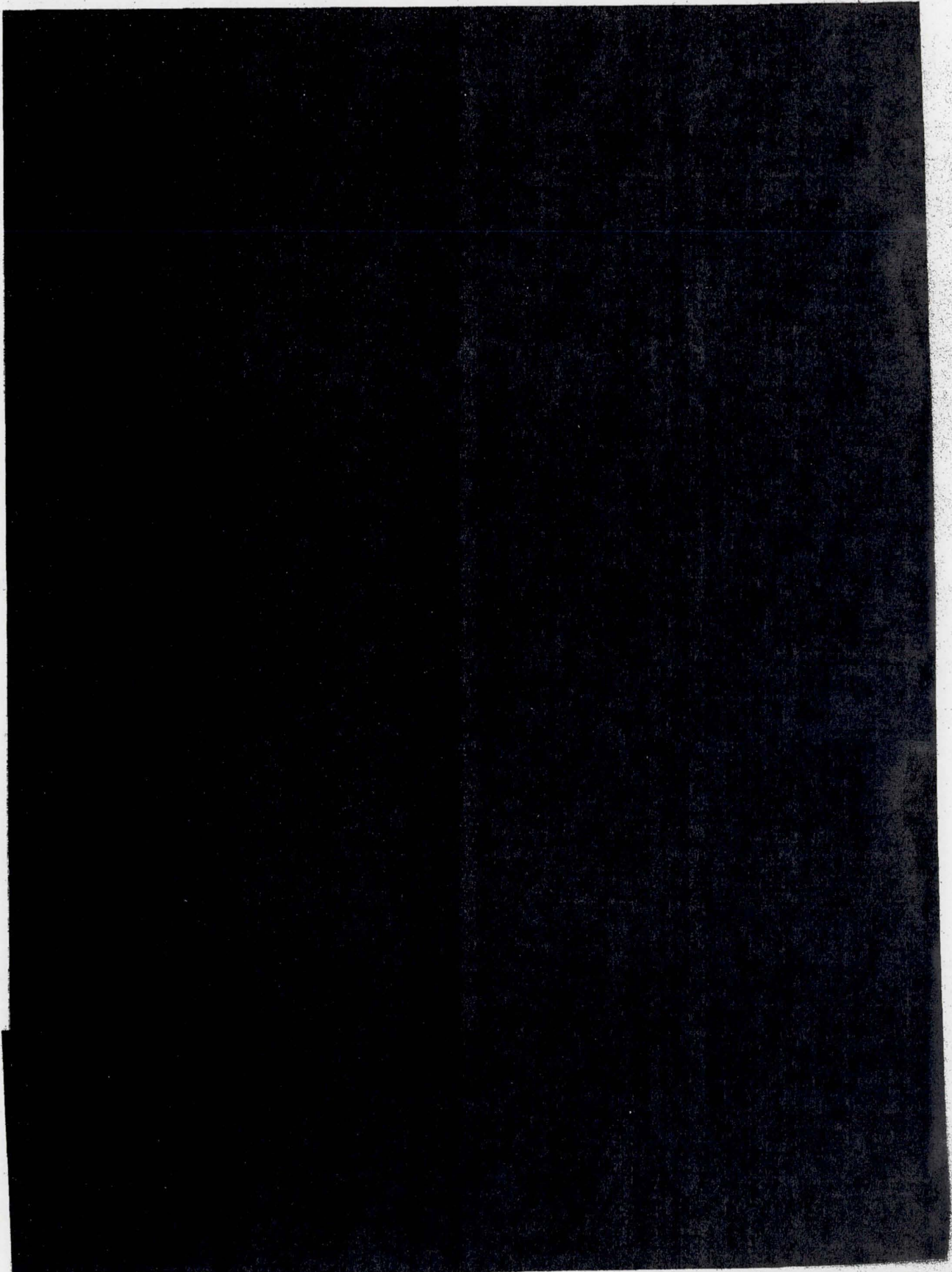

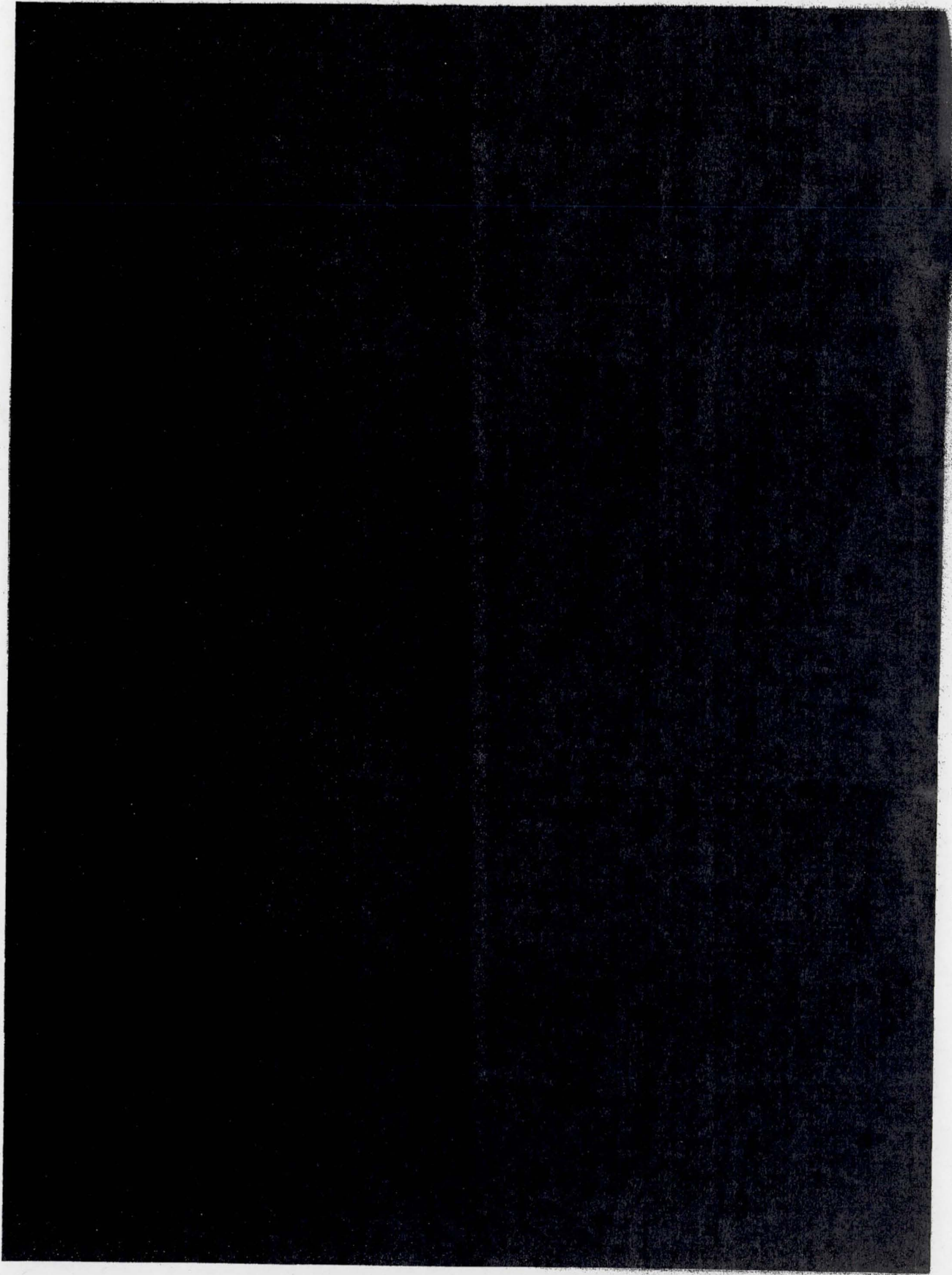

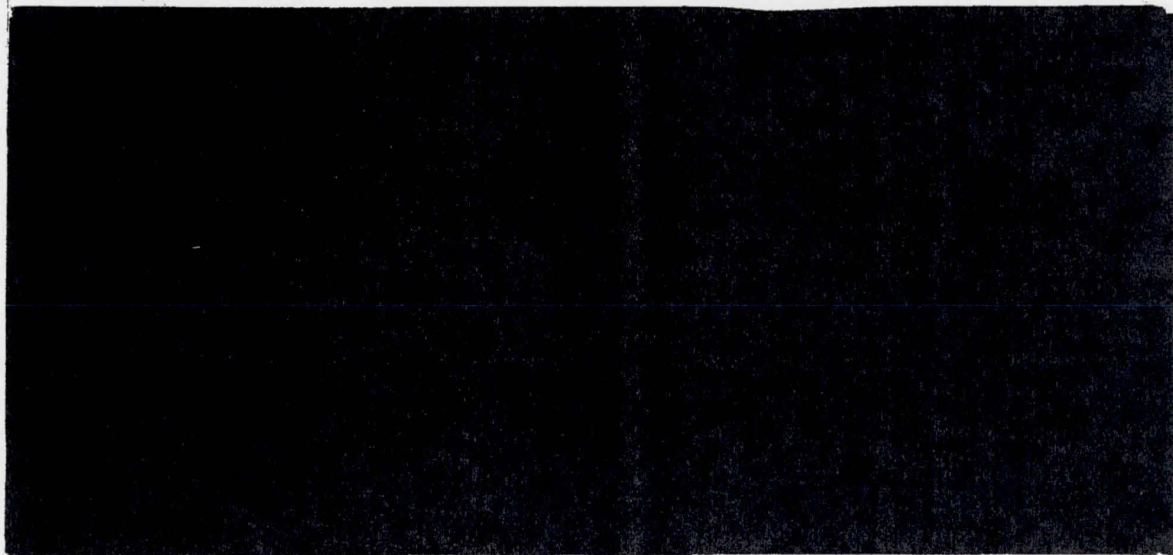

REAR ADMIRAL D G SNELSON
UNITED KINGDOM MARITIME CONTINGENT COMMANDER (UKMCC)

APPOINTMENT

1. You are appointed as the UKMCC for OP TELIC and are to exercise TACOM of UK assets assigned to you.

MISSION

2. You are to:

- a. Conduct Op RESINATE tasks in accordance with Enclosure 1.
- b. Contribute to CFMCC's planning, co-ordination and conduct of operations to defeat/destroy Iraqi military capability.
- c. Prepare the ATG for amphibious operations in support of CFLCC activity in Southern Iraq.
- d. Prepare the UK MCM Group for operations in support of CFMCC activity in Iraqi Territorial and Internal Waters and in the approaches to SPODs and along SLOCs within the JOA.
- e. Continue to provide sea based support to elements of 3 Cdo Bde when ashore.
- f. Provide support and sustainment of UK maritime and coalition forces within the UK JOA.
- g. Provide support for the conduct and sustainment of TLAM operations.
- h. Contribute to the CFMCC's Force Protection programme, safeguarding entitled UK and Coalition maritime interests in the UK JOA.
- i. Contribute to existing MIOPS in support of UN sanctions against Iraq, whilst preparing for the interdiction of key members of the Iraqi/AQ Leadership.
- j. Be prepared to contribute to Coalition JPR tasking.
- k. Be prepared to support national/coalition SF operations in the UK JOA.
- m. Conduct ISR operations in support of coalition objectives.
- n. Be prepared to support the Coalition Information Operations.

MAJOR GENERAL R V BRIMS CBE
UNITED KINGDOM LAND CONTINGENT COMMANDER (UKLCC)

APPOINTMENT

1. You are appointed the UKLCC for Op TELIC and you are to exercise TACOM¹ of all UK assets assigned to you.

MISSION

2. You are to:
- a. Contribute to CG 1 MEF's planning, co-ordination and conduct of operations to defeat/destroy Iraqi military capability south of the River EUPHRATES, within Corps boundaries of 1 MEF².
 - b. Within your area of responsibility, identify and establish conditions to transition to Phase IV operations then enable and conduct Phase IV activity. Be prepared establish interim civil and military administration within occupied Iraqi territory.
 - c. Be prepared to support Coalition Information Operations within the Divisional battlespace and with specific focus on Phase IV operations.
 - d. Be prepared to conduct operations in support of 1 MEF north of the River EUPHRATES subject to UK ministerial approval.
 - e. Be prepared to support SSE operations throughout the 1 MEF battlespace.
 - f. Establish Force Protection measures in the KUWAIT/IRAQ AO.
 - g. Be prepared to assist in the initial enabling of the northern LoC.
 - h. Be prepared to support Humanitarian Assistance operations in the UK JOA
 - i. Be prepared to support national SF operations in the IRAQ OA (scale to be clarified).
