INTELLIGENCE GAINED

DEATH OF IRAQI POLICE SERVICE MEMBERS

1. On the morning of 18 Dec 04, members of the Iraqi Police Service (IPS) who were manning a checkpoint outside AZ ZUBAYR [REDACTED] stated that two IPS members and their wives had been killed earlier that morning. One killing had occurred in AZ ZUBAYR and the other in BASRA. It was also stated that the killers had been wearing IPS uniforms. The purpose of the checkpoint was to locate a Chevrolet Caprice (NFDK).

2. The local population have noticed that there has been an increase in killings over the last three months, but that this last month has seen an even bigger increase in the numbers murdered. The local populace are becoming more fearful and do not know the reason for the upsurge in violence, but believe that the majority of the problems are being fuelled by Iranians.

FHT Comment: Para 5, 4 Bde Overnight Summary 171830CDEC04 – 180630CDEC04, mentions the death of Abdul HUSSEIN, a Captain in the IPS on the night of 17 Dec 04. It is not known whether the IPS officer killed in BASRA, as detailed in Para 1 above, is this individual. **Comment Ends.**
