

ACCESS METHOD	MODUS OPERANDI (Narrative)	EVIDENCE RECOVERED
Insecure	<p>About 1757 hrs on 17 Dec 04, a shooting incident occurred on Route TOPEKA, South of Al Basrah Province. A two vehicle C/S from 40 Cdo RM, Az Zubayr Port (AZP), BFPO 643, encountered a civilian vehicle which they believed to be a SVIED. The vehicle failed to slow down when instructed to do so by the C/S, therefore three (3) warning shots were fired at the vehicle bonnet in order to immobilise the vehicle. It is alleged that the driver of the vehicle then responded by firing a burst of automatic fire at the patrol. The vehicle was subsequently engaged by the four top cover sentries of the C/S. During the engagement, at total of 42 x 5.56 mm rounds were expended. All members of the C/S subsequently extracted to SLB, therefore it was not confirmed whether the occupant(s) of the vehicle were killed or injured during the incident. 	<p>I examined two MOD vehicles on charge to 40 Cdo RM. The vehicles were a Pinz Gauer, VRN: 79 KL 72 and a Land Rover Wolf, VRN: PE 20 AA. I examined the vehicles for any sign of damage consistent with being struck by any missile, shot or projectile.</p> <p>Neither vehicle showed any signs of damage consistent with such a strike. I then photographed both vehicles using a Nikon F90X 35mm camera, loaded with 100 ASA film. I retained the exposed film in my possession. To be forwarded to the Central Processing Cell, HQ SIB (UK) RMP, Bulford, via the registered mail system, for development.</p>
