

NOTICE OF PROPOSAL TO MODIFY PUBLIC PATH ORDER

HIGHWAYS ACT 1980

Notice is hereby given pursuant to paragraph 2(3) of Schedule 6 to the Highways Act 1980 that the Inspector appointed by the Secretary of State for Environment, Food and Rural Affairs to determine the Council of the City of Wakefield Public Path Diversion Order and Definitive Map and Statement Modification Order No 7, 2015 Public Footpath Ossett No 2 proposes to modify the order by providing for the following modifications:-

- (i) Amend the Schedule PART 1 to describe the existing FP2 as a 1.5 metre wide public footpath;
- (ii) Amend the Schedule PART 2 to describe the proposed alternative as a 1.5 metre wide public footpath;
- (iii) Amend the Schedule PART 3 description of new statement entry by deleting the words "6 stiles" and adding in the words "4 stiles and 2 kissing gates", and
- (iv) Amend the Schedule PART 3 table of Proposed Statement (column nine) by deleting the words "6 stiles" and adding in the words "4 stiles and 2 kissing gates".

A copy of the order as submitted and a copy of the order showing the proposed modification together with the Inspector's Order decision dated 15 February 2018 have been deposited at Customer Services Desk, Wakefield One, Burton Street, Wakefield and may be inspected free of charge during normal working hours.
