JUDGMENT

The unanimous Judgment of the tribunal is that:

1. The respondent did not unlawfully discriminate against the claimant because of her sex or age.
2. The respondent did not unlawfully indirectly discriminate against the claimant (sex).
3. The respondent did not unlawfully harass the claimant related to race or sex or age.
4. The respondent did not unlawfully victimise the claimant.
5. The claimant was not constructively discriminatorily dismissed by the respondent.
6. The claimant is ordered to pay to the respondent costs in the total sum of £2,823.50.
