JUDGMENT

The unanimous Judgment of the tribunal is that:

- 1. The respondent did not unlawfully discriminate against the claimant because of her sex or age.
- 2. The respondent did not unlawfully indirectly discriminate against the claimant (sex).
- 3. The respondent did not unlawfully harass the claimant related to race or sex or age.
- 4. The respondent did not unlawfully victimise the claimant.
- 5. The claimant was not constructively discriminatorily dismissed by the respondent.
- 6. The claimant is ordered to pay to the respondent costs in the total sum of £2,823.50.
