### SPLI - QUARTERLY UPDATE - 1 Jul to 30 Sep17

#### 1. Introduction and Aim

- 1.1 On 10 Feb 17, the Secretary of State announced the Iraq Historic Allegations Team (IHAT) would close and remaining investigations would be reintegrated into the Service Police system. As a result, Service Police Legacy Investigations (SPLI) was formed.
- 1.2 SPLI comprises Royal Navy Police (RNP) and Royal Air Force Police (RAFP) personnel. They are supported by Civil Service staff and also a number of contractors who fulfil specialist, back office, support functions, such as the managing of the Forensic Handling Data Centre (FDHC). SPLI is led by a senior RNP officer.
- 1.3. The aim of this document is to ensure the public have access to relevant information that details the progress made by SPLI.

## 2. Executive Summary

- 2.1 This is the first quarterly report of Service Police Legacy Investigations (SPLI). It covers the period from 1 Jul 17 to 30 Sep 17.
- 2.2 SPLI inherited its caseload on 1 Jul 17 when the remaining Iraq legacy allegations were reintegrated into the Service Police system. Since then, it has disposed of around 33% of its caseload closing, or in the process of closing, 410 allegations. At present it has 737 allegations that remain in case assessment.
- 2.3 SPLI currently has 25 Full Investigations and 20 Directed Lines of Enquiry, which account for 115 allegations. An individual investigation or a directed line can be made up of multiple allegations. It is important to note that one allegation does not always equate to a single investigation or a directed line.
- 2.4 SPLI is performing as anticipated and expects to complete the majority of its investigations around the end of 2018.

# 3. Caseload

3.1 SPLI inherited a total of 1262 allegations.

3.2. SPLI currently has 25 Full Investigations and 20 Directed Lines of Enquiry at 30 Sep 17.

3.2. Since 1 Jul 17, 410 allegations have been closed or are in the process of being closed. This equates to 33% of the inherited caseload being processed in the first three months of operation. Allegations can be closed at various stages of the process.

#### 4. Referrals

4.1 SPLI inherited one referral from IHAT to the Service Prosecuting Authority (SPA). It has since been discontinued by the SPA.
