JUDGMENT

The Judgment of the Tribunal is as follows:

- 1 The name of the Respondent is amended to Magenta Security Services Ltd.
- 2 The claim against Mr Petkar is dismissed upon withdrawal by the Claimant.
- 3 Leave to amend to include claims set out in the Claimant's application to the Tribunal submitted on 12 June 2017 refusal.
- 4 By consent the Respondent is to pay £104.11 to the Claimant, subject to deduction of tax and national insurance, by way of unlawful deduction from wages.

5 The Respondent's application for costs is refused.
