The Application for Anonymity form should be used when applying to the tribunal to remove references to your name from all published documents.

You should complete each section fully including your full name, date of birth and address. Where you are applying for anonymity you should include your your appeal number. This will help the tribunal correctly identify your appeal. Please also include details of your legal representative, should you have one.

You need to provide the tribunal with reasons why you consider your appeal should be granted anonymity. Please use the box provided for this purpose and attach additional sheets should you need to. It is important that you provide full reasons why you are applying for anonymity on the form.

Please ensure that you read and understand the notes on the form, particularly regarding your own responsibility to maintain anonymity, before signing and dating the declaration.
