Preliminary flood risk assessment: Lincolnshire County Council

This addendum by Lincolnshire County Council (2017) updates the council's preliminary flood risk assessment report published in 2011. Read the addendum in conjunction with the preliminary assessment report.

Addendum

The preliminary flood risk assessment (PFRA) and flood risk areas (FRAs) for Lincolnshire County Council (LCC) were reviewed during 2017, using all relevant current flood risk data and information.

There are no changes to the assessment of risk since the preliminary assessment report was published in 2011.

The annexes to the preliminary assessment report have been reviewed and updated to show relevant new information since 2011. No relevant updates are identified as a result of the review.

Past flood risk

With reference to all locally agreed surface water information, no records of past floods with national level significant harmful consequences have been identified in Lincolnshire since the preliminary assessment report was produced in 2011.

Future flood risk

With reference to all locally agreed surface water information, no areas at risk of future flooding with national level significant harmful consequences have been identified in Lincolnshire.

The updated surface water flood risk maps, guidance on allowances for climate change, the Council's Communities at Risk Project and the current Strategic Flood Risk Assessments have all helped to improve the quality - and therefore understanding of the impact on future flood risk - of the information created by and provided to LCC.

Flood risk areas (FRAs)

No new FRAs have been identified in the Lincolnshire County Council LLFA Area for the purposes of the Flood Risk Regulations (2009) second planning cycle.

Other changes

Changes introduced sine the first PFRA report include:

The creation of a dedicated Flood Risk & Development Management Group to carry out the County Council's operational flood risk management and statutory consultee roles.
