Preliminary flood risk assessment: Rotherham Metropolitan Borough Council

This addendum by Rotherham Metropolitan Borough Council (2017) updates the council's preliminary flood risk assessment report published in 2011. Read the addendum in conjunction with the <u>preliminary assessment report</u>.

Addendum

The preliminary flood risk assessment (PFRA) and flood risk areas (FRAs) for Rotherham Metropolitan Borough Council were reviewed during 2017, using all relevant current flood risk data and information.

Following the 2017 review, there are no changes to the assessment of risk since the preliminary assessment report was published in 2011.

The annexes to the preliminary assessment report have been reviewed. No updates have been added as all recorded flooding incidents since 2011 have been below threshold.

Past flood risk

No changes to the 2011 assessment.

Future flood risk

Surface water management plans have been completed covering Wath-upon-Dearne, Aston, Anston and Forge Island. The plans provide more detail of the flood risk in these areas. Modelled risk data unchanged for other areas. Minor flood incidents since 2011 have provided additional information about some localised flood risk.

Flood risk areas (FRAs)

No FRAs have been identified for the purposes of the Flood Risk Regulations (2009) 2nd planning cycle.

Other changes

No significant changes since the 2011 assessment.
