

Preliminary flood risk assessment: Knowsley Borough Council

This addendum by Knowsley Borough Council (2017) updates the council's preliminary flood risk assessment report published in 2011. Read the addendum in conjunction with the [preliminary assessment report](#).

Addendum

The preliminary flood risk assessment (PFRA) and flood risk areas (FRAs) for Knowsley Metropolitan Borough Council were reviewed during 2017, using all relevant current flood risk data and information.

There are no changes to the assessment of flood risk since the preliminary flood risk assessment (PFRA) report was published in 2011.

Therefore there have been no changes, updates or new information added to the annexes of the preliminary flood risk assessment (PFRA) report.

Past flood risk

No significant flood events have occurred since the publication of the original PFRA report in December 2011 that have added to or changed our understanding of significant flood risk in the borough of Knowsley.

Future flood risk

Knowsley Council adopted its Local Plan Core Strategy in January 2016; with policy CS24 specifically for managing flood risk. No additional information to improve our understanding of future flood risk, impact of climate change or long term development in the borough of Knowsley has been created or received by the LLFA; and therefore our knowledge of the flood risk remains the same.

Flood risk areas (FRAs)

No FRAs have been identified in the Knowsley lead local flood authority (LLFA) area for the purposes of the Flood Risk Regulations second planning cycle.

Other changes

The PFRA review has not identified any important changes required to the information contained in the original report, in relation to the assessment of flood risk in Knowsley.
