

Preliminary flood risk assessment: Blackburn with Darwen Borough Council

Addendum

The preliminary flood risk assessment (PFRA) and flood risk areas (FRAs) for Blackburn with Darwen Borough Council (BwDBC) were reviewed during May 2017, using all relevant current flood risk data and information.

Past flood risk

No significant flooding occurred within the lead local flood authority (LLFA) area since 2011.

Future flood risk

Our understanding of future floods, climate change and long term developments hasn't changed since 2011. However in line with government guideline the climate change allowance within the FRA has been changed to minimise vulnerability and provide resilience to future flood risk.

Flood risk areas (FRAs)

The following FRAs have been identified for the purposes of the Flood Risk Regulations (2009) second planning cycle.
