Preliminary flood risk assessment: Durham County Council

This addendum by Durham County Council (2017) updates the council's preliminary flood risk assessment report published in 2011. Read the addendum in conjunction with the preliminary assessment report.

Addendum

The preliminary flood risk assessment (PFRA) and flood risk areas (FRAs) for Durham County Council were reviewed during 2017, using all relevant current flood risk data and information.

A review of the flood risk in the area covered by Durham County Council has been completed, and no new flood risks have been identified since the last PRFA produced in 2011.

The annexes to the preliminary assessment report from 2011 have been reviewed and no new relevant updates are identified as a result of the review.

Past flood risk

There is no change in the understanding of flood risk since the production of the PFRA in 2011.

Future flood risk

There is no change in the understanding of future flood risk since the production of the PFRA in 2011.

Flood risk areas (FRAs)

No FRAs have been identified for the purposes of the Flood Risk Regulations (2009) 2nd planning cycle.
