

Preliminary flood risk assessment: Redcar and Cleveland Borough Council

This addendum by Redcar and Cleveland Borough Council (2017) updates the council's preliminary flood risk assessment report published in 2011. Read the addendum in conjunction with the [preliminary assessment report](#).

Addendum

The preliminary flood risk assessment (PFRA) and flood risk areas (FRAs) for Redcar and Cleveland Borough Council were reviewed during 2017, using all relevant current flood risk data and information.

There is no change to our assessment of risk since the preliminary assessment report was published in 2011.

Past flood risk

Our current understanding of significant flood risk in our LLFA area has not changed as a result of the consequences of floods that have occurred since 2011.

Future flood risk

Our understanding of flood risk in the LLFA area has not changed since 2011 as a result of future floods, the impact of climate change or long term developments.

Flood risk areas (FRAs)

No FRAs have been identified in the Redcar and Cleveland Council area for the purposes of the Flood Risk Regulations (2009) second planning cycle.

Other changes

There are no other updates or changes which we consider important in relation to the assessment of flood risk in our area.
