

Preliminary flood risk assessment: North Tyneside Council

This addendum by North Tyneside Council (2017) updates the council's preliminary flood risk assessment report published in 2011. Read the addendum in conjunction with the [preliminary assessment report](#).

Addendum

The preliminary flood risk assessment (PFRA) and flood risk areas (FRAs) for North Tyneside Council were reviewed during 2017, using all relevant current flood risk data and information.

North Tyneside Council have no change to assessment of risk following the review.

Past flood risk

The significant flood risk in the LLFA area has not changed as a result of the floods that have occurred since 2011.

Future flood risk

Following publication of the latest Environment Agency Flood Risk data we have carried out a review of the properties identified as being at risk from Fluvial, Pluvial and Groundwater flooding. This identified a reduction in the number of houses at risk from flooding the data from this is contained in Annex 2.

Flood risk areas (FRAs)

No FRAs have been identified in the North Tyneside lead local flood authority area for the purposes of the Flood Risk Regulations second planning cycle.
