Preliminary flood risk assessment: Telford and Wrekin Council

This addendum by Telford and Wrekin Council (2017) updates the council's preliminary flood risk assessment report published in 2011. Read the addendum in conjunction with the <u>preliminary assessment report</u>.

Addendum

The preliminary flood risk assessment (PFRA) and flood risk areas (FRAs) for Telford and Wrekin Council were reviewed during 2017, using all relevant current flood risk data and information.

There have been no changes to Telford and Wrekin Councils assessment of risk following the review of the PFRA.

Past flood risk

Although Telford and Wrekin Council have experienced localised flood events since the publication of the PFRA in 2011, none of these events have altered our understanding of, or resulted in the identification of new areas of significant risk within the Borough.

Future flood risk

Telford and Wrekin Council have not created or received any new information that has changed our understanding of significant flood risk in Borough since publication of the PFRA report in 2011.

Telford and Wrekin Council have however received guidance from the Environment Agency regarding future climate change. This guidance will be incorporated into Council Policy following the publication of an SPD relating to Sustainable Drainage on new development.

Flood risk areas (FRAs)

No FRAs were identified in the Borough as part of the publication of the PFRA in 2011. Telford and Wrekin Council have not identified any new FRAs for the purposes of the Flood Risk Regulations second planning cycle.
