

Preliminary flood risk assessment: Bournemouth Borough Council

This addendum by Bournemouth Borough Council (2017) updates the council's preliminary flood risk assessment report published in 2011. Read the addendum in conjunction with the [preliminary assessment report](#).

Addendum

The preliminary flood risk assessment (PFRA) and flood risk areas (FRAs) for Bournemouth Borough Council were reviewed during 2017, using all relevant current flood risk data and information.

Further modelling has indicated that the main areas of surface water flooding are still in generally the same locations but are not quite as extensive as identified in the original PFRA and the estimate of the total number of properties at risk has consequently fallen.

Past flood risk

There have been a number of flood events since 2011 but these have generally confirmed the locations of predicted flooding.

Future flood risk

Further modelling has generally confirmed locations of surface water flooding but magnitude/extent is not now believed to be as large.

Flood risk areas (FRAs)

No FRAs have been identified in the Bournemouth Borough Council area the purposes of the Flood Risk Regulations (2009) second planning cycle.
