

Preliminary flood risk assessment: Council of the Isles of Scilly

This addendum by the Council of the Isles of Scilly (2017) updates the council's preliminary flood risk assessment report published in 2011. Read the addendum in conjunction with the [preliminary assessment report](#).

Addendum

The preliminary flood risk assessment (PFRA) and flood risk areas (FRAs) for the Council of the Isles of Scilly were reviewed during 2017, using all relevant current flood risk data and information.

For the area of the Isles of Scilly there is no change to our assessment of risk following the review.

Past flood risk

The only significant threat of flooding to the islands is from coastal flooding and erosion. The risk from fluvial and pluvial flooding is extremely low and there have been no past local events from surface water or groundwater.

Future flood risk

The only significant threat of flooding to the islands is from coastal flooding and erosion. The risk from fluvial and pluvial flooding is extremely low and there have been no past local events from surface water or groundwater.

Flood risk areas (FRAs)

No FRAs have been identified in the Council of the Isles of Scilly area for the purposes of the Flood Risk Regulations (2009) second planning cycle.
