Preliminary flood risk assessment: Dorset County Council

This addendum by Dorset County Council (2017) updates the council's preliminary flood risk assessment report published in 2011. Read the addendum in conjunction with the preliminary assessment report.

Addendum

The preliminary flood risk assessment (PFRA) and flood risk areas (FRAs) for Dorset County Council were reviewed during 2017, using all relevant current flood risk data and information.

There is no change to the assessment of risk since the preliminary assessment report was published in 2011.

Past flood risk

Dorset County Council will continue in accordance with our agreed threshold trigger (5 residential, 2 commercial and 1 critical infrastructure on severing of transport link) for significant floods, to report those floods under section 19¹ of the FWMA.

Future flood risk

No change since the preliminary assessment report was published in 2011.
