I am writing in response to your request for information regarding the below. Your request has been handled under Section 1(1) of the Freedom of Information Act 2000. In accordance with Section 1(1) (a) of the Act I hereby confirm that the CNC/CNPA does not hold information of the type specified. Please see attached information. The data for this financial year is exempt under S22 Intended for future publication.

For the financial years 2012/2013, 2013/2014, 2014/2015, 2015/2016, 2016/2017 and available data for 2017/2018, I would like to be provided with details on donations, gifts, sponsorships and loans that have been received by the police force.

- 1. For each donation, gift, sponsorship and loan, please provide the following information:
- a) The financial year that the donation, gift, sponsorship and loan was received
- b) The sum or value (if known) and description of the donation, gift, sponsorship and loan
- c) If known, what the donation, gift, sponsorship and loan was subsequently used for e.g. a donation passed to teams working with the local community, or a gift subsequently used in a charity raffle
- 2. For each donation, gift, sponsorship and loan, please provide further information regarding where the donation, gift, sponsorship and loan came from:
- a) If it was an individual, please provide the full name and title of the individual who awarded the donation, gift, sponsorship or loan
- b) If it was a government department or another public authority such as a council that awarded the donation, gift, sponsorship or loan, please provide the name of that government department or public authority
- c) If it was a company or organisation or group that awarded the donation, gift, sponsorship or loan, please provide the name of that company or organisation or group d) If it was a foundation or charity that awarded the donation, gift, sponsorship or loan, please provide the name of that foundation or charity

The Civil Nuclear Constabulary is a specialist armed police service dedicated to the civil nuclear industry, with Operational Policing Units based at 10 civil nuclear sites in England and Scotland and over 1400 police officers and staff. The Constabulary headquarters is at Culham in

Oxfordshire. The civil nuclear industry forms part of the UK's critical national infrastructure and the role of the Constabulary contribute to the overall framework of national security.

The purpose of the Constabulary is to protect licensed civil nuclear sites and to safeguard nuclear material in transit. The Constabulary works in partnership with the appropriate Home Office Police Force or Police Scotland at each site. Policing services required at each site are agreed with nuclear operators in accordance with the Nuclear Industries Security Regulations 2003 and ratified by the UK regulator, the Office for Nuclear Regulation (ONR). Armed policing services are required at most civil nuclear sites in the United Kingdom. The majority of officers in the Constabulary are Authorised Firearms Officers.

The Constabulary is recognised by the National Police Chiefs' Council (NPCC) and the Association of Chief Police Officers in Scotland (ACPOS). Through the National Coordinated Policing Protocol, the Constabulary has established memorandums of understanding with the local police forces at all 10 Operational Policing Units. Mutual support and assistance enable the Constabulary to maintain focus on its core role.

We take our responsibilities under the Freedom of Information Act seriously but, if you feel your request has not been properly handled or you are otherwise dissatisfied with the outcome of your request, you have the right to complain. We will investigate the matter and endeavour to reply within 3-6 weeks. You should write in the first instance to:
