THE ENVIRONMENTAL PERMITTING (ENGLAND AND WALES) REGULATIONS 2016 (TRICOYA VENTURES UK LIMITED) EXERCISE OF FUNCTIONS DIRECTION 2018

The Secretary of State gives the following Direction to the Environment Agency in exercise of the power conferred by regulation 33(1)(a) of the Environmental Permitting (England and Wales) Regulations 2016(a).

Citation and commencement

1.—(1) This Direction may be cited as the Environmental Permitting (England and Wales) Regulations 2016 (Tricoya Ventures UK Limited) Exercise of Functions Direction 2018.

(2) It comes into force on 12 April 2018.

Exercise of functions

2.—(1) Functions under the Environmental Permitting (England and Wales) Regulations 2016 in relation to the relevant operation are exercisable by the Environment Agency for an indeterminate period, unless a further direction is issued under regulation 33(1).

(2) For the purposes of this Direction, "relevant operation" means the operation by Tricoya Ventures Limited (company registration no: 10087465) at the premises mentioned in the Schedule of a facility to manufacture acetylated wood elements which falls within paragraph (a) of Part A(2) of Section 6.6 of Chapter 6 of Part 2 of Schedule 1 to the Environmental Permitting (England and Wales) Regulations 2016.
